

## **Completion of Studies**

Additional information for the completion of the <u>MSc programme Data Science</u> complementary to the official <u>guide</u>.

**Summary** (also see §3-12 of the <u>curriculum</u>):

- Complete all required courses.
- Complete the required internship.
- Fill out the <u>Prüfungspass</u> and send it to the examination office (<u>das.Pruefungsreferat@plus.ac.at</u>).
- Hand in your master thesis as described in the official <u>guide</u>.
- Organise your master's examination.

## Master's Examination

General procedure (also see §12 of the curriculum):

- 15-20 minutes presentation of your master thesis
- 15-20 minutes examination subject 1 (related to the scientific area of your master thesis)
- 15-20 minutes examination subject 2 (taken from any mandatory or elective module)

## Organisation:

- 1. The master's examination is conducted by three professors: two examiners and one chairperson. One of the persons is the supervisor of your master thesis. You need to coordinate with the professors to find a date and time.
- 2. Fill out <u>this document</u> and send it to the examination office (<u>das.Pruefungsreferat@plus.ac.at</u>).
- 3. Subsequently, you receive a document for the confirmation of the examination date. *This document must be handed in two weeks before the exam*!
- Book a room for your exam. For the computer science building at Jakob-Haringer-Straße 2, 5020 Salzburg you can email Anita Bilke (<u>anita.bilke@plus.ac.at</u>) or Elisabeth Riedl (<u>elisabeth.riedl@plus.ac.at</u>).

## Additional Information:

• The name of the examination subject is usually a module name, and the examination content of this module is to be arranged with the professors. It can be lecture material and/or additional book chapters/papers.



- The chairperson must be a professor involved in the data science master's programme. An overview is available at <a href="https://datascience.plus.ac.at/">https://datascience.plus.ac.at/</a>, under Data Science Faculty. The other two examiners are usually also professors. Exceptions can be made for lecturers with a doctorate if this person has taught core courses in a module.
- If one of the examination subjects is applied (e.g., Geoinformatics, Bioinformatics, Philosophy), then the other should be methodological (e.g., Statistics, Computer Science). However, both can also be methodological.
- The presentation of your master thesis is not part of the final grade. It is calculated as the average of the two subject examinations.
